Subject: **Consular Camps in Oklahoma & Dallas**

Concept:

The Consulate General of Pakistan was established in Houston in August 2004. The Mission has jurisdiction over 10 States with approximately 220K Pakistani descent diaspora in Texas, Florida, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Arkansas, Oklahoma, Colorado and New Mexico. In order to meet the challenge of long distance, the Mission facilitates the Community by visiting their doorsteps, through Consular Camps.

- Power of Attorney (General & Special);
 - Registration of birth;
 - Verification of US documents (already attested by State Department);
 - Life Certificate;
 - Marriage Certificate;
 - Affidavits;
 - Facilitation for online applications for E-visa, Passport and NICOP; and
 - Special Assistance for those traveling in an emergency.

Facilities/Equipments to be provided by the Hosts, at the Camp:

- i) Sitting Area (service hall) with appropriate capacity according to the number of people expected, along with sitting arrangements including 2/3 writing desks;
- ii) One PC with high speed (Ethernet) Internet connection & necessary accessories;
- iii) Photocopier with paper (A4 size);
- iv) A good speed Scanner;
- v) Drinking water/tea stall;
- vi) Suitable number of volunteers to assist collection and return of documents.
